

Steps for completing the Psychology Major (Semester II): (All students must complete Semester II requirements.)

PRE-PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR

- Psychology 1010: General Psychology
- 10 credit hours at the U of U, with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or better.
- OR** if you do not have a U of U GPA, 10 transfer hours with a transfer GPA of 2.8 or better.



- Apply for Intermediate-major Status at the Psychology Advising Center (BEH S 507)



INTERMEDIATE PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR

- Psychology 3000: Statistical Methods in Psychology
- Psychology 3010: Research Methods in Psychology
- Current U of U cumulative GPA of 2.8 or better



- Apply for Full-major Status at the Psychology Advising Center (BEH S 507)



PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR

- Complete the remaining requirements for Semester II. See checklist on reverse side. To set up an appointment to go over your specific requirements call 585-9095.

NOTE: The following are important policy issues that may affect your graduation. Please contact us if you have questions about any of the following:

- PSY 1220: Psychology of Infancy and Childhood and PSY 3220: Childhood and Adolescent Development **cannot both** be counted toward a psychology major.
- Field Placement (4810) and Research Assistance (4800-4806) are to be taken as CR/NC. **Only six (6) total hours between these courses** may be counted toward the psychology major. For each credit hour earned, you must complete three (3) hours of work per week.
- With the exception of PSY 1010 and 3000, classes taken over ten (10) years ago do not fulfill departmental requirements.
- Students must complete ten (10) semester hours of psychology course work at the University of Utah; eight (8) hours must be 3000 or higher to satisfy the Psychology Department residency requirement.
- All psychology and allied hours must be completed with a letter grade of “C” or better (C- is not acceptable) and an overall cumulative **GPA of 2.8 or better** must be maintained to update to the next level in the major.
- Core courses may be repeated only once; a repeat course form must be turned in to the Registrar (Window #13, Student Services Building) after **ANY** repeated course.
- Lower-division courses **do not** satisfy core requirements.
- Psychology credit hours must total **at least 38 hours**. Of those 38, **25 hours must be 3000 or higher**. There is no maximum to the number of psychology credits which may be counted toward University graduation requirements.
- When updating to Intermediate- or Full-major status, you must bring a current **transcript or DARS to the Psychology Advising Center (BEH S 507)**. It may take up to one week to update your status.
- Modes of Learning may not be taken by themselves; they must be taken with the courses to which they are attached.
